GBSI is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization formed in 2006 to promote awareness and prevention of group B strep disease in babies during pregnancy through early infancy.

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

According to the World Health Organization, an average of 15% of all pregnant women worldwide – nearly 20 million annually – carry group B strep which is a major, yet preventable, cause of maternal and infant ill health globally. Most of these women are currently unidentified and untreated.

Annual burden of GBS in numbers for the year 2020:

- 518,000 GBS-associated preterm births
- 390.000 infant GBS cases
- 91.000 newborn deaths
- 46.000+ stillbirths
- 40,000 infants living with neurological impairment following GBSassociated infections

GBS can also cause chronic and non-chronic GBS vaginitis as well as urinary tract infection in pregnant and non-pregnant individuals. Additionally, GBS can also cause life-threatening infections, such as bacteremia, pneumonia, and skin and bone infections among non-pregnant adults - most often presenting in the elderly and those with compromised immune systems.

The annual burden of GBS for non-pregnant adults worldwide is unknown, but according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the US, an average of 1 in 20 non-pregnant adults with serious GBS infections dies.

Another area of emerging concern is how GBS colonization and iGBS can be transmitted between humans, animals, and the environment, known as the One Health approach.

Your support will also spur research to inform GBS vaccine development and future implementation of a much-needed prevention strategy.
