- engaging health agency and nonprofit representatives to share GBS awareness with their audience

3,500,000 preterm births may be attributable to GBS. ¹

57,000 possibly even up to **314,600** unborn babies die in their mother's womb or are born very sick due to GBS. ^{1, 2, 3}

205,000 babies are infected with GBS within the first week of life.

114,000 babies are infected with GBS between the first week of life up to several months of age.¹






